

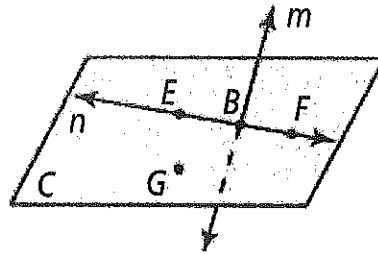
Ex. 2. If possible, draw a figure to fit each description. Otherwise, write not possible.
